

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Green Acres Subdivision Sewer System, Inc. pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6-1, will file with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission a 30-Day Filing allowing the cost of disconnection and reconnection of service to be paid by the customer in case of delinquency. This fee applies only to those customers who become delinquent over 90 days. Customers will receive billing of the actual cost of disconnection and reconnection, the estimated cost of which is furnished to the customer with the cutoff notice. The customer shall pay the actual expenses incurred to be reconnected. The corporation also includes a request to have a \$30.00 charge applied to a customer's account whose check is returned by the bank due to non-sufficient funds or other reasons (one charge per check each time it is returned). We expect to file this by August 27, 2021. A commission decision on this 30-Day Filing is anticipated no sooner than 30 days after the date of filing. Objection to this filing should be made to either the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission or the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor.
